A STITCH-AWEIGH EVENT UPDATE NOTICE

We've been waiting for the 2012 rates to be published so that we could book a Stitching Cruise to Alaska. Those rates were released a few weeks ago and Fred was working with the cruise line to get a price. Long story short, in order to spend 3 days on land and then cruise to Vancouver, the best rate was going to start above \$2000 per person plus airfare.

So Fred was surfing the cruise lines and found the cruise below. He has already booked us on the cruise. This will not be an official "Group" or "Stitching Cruise" but that won't stop us from finding a place congregate and stitch.

**ROYAL CARIBBEAN LINES, VOYAGER OF THE SEAS
FROM NEW ORLEANS TO BARCELONA, SPAIN
APRIL 14-30, 2012**

This is a repositioning cruise, which means the boat is moving from it's winter port in NOLA to it's summer port in Europe so it's a one way cruise. You will need to fly home from Europe. What makes this so great is that the fare is unbelievable: ranging from \$570 per person for an inside cabin to \$970 per person for a balcony cabin. This is for a 16-day cruise! The ship will make port calls at Nassau, Bahamas; Ponta Delaga, Azores; Malaga, Spain; Cartagena, Spain; Valencia, Spain and dock in Barcelona, Spain.

**ROYAL CARIBBEAN LINES, VOYAGER OF THE SEAS
FROM BARCELONA, SPAIN TO VENICE, ITALY
APRIL 30-MAY 11, 2012**

Fred is never one to stop when he can continue without interruption, so he also booked us to continue onto the next ports of call for the ship. That means that we get to tour Barcelona and get back onto the ship in our same cabin and travel to Provence, France; Ajaccio, Corsica; Florence (Pisa), Italy; Rome, Italy; Naples, Italy; Messina, Sicily; Dubrovnik, Croatia; Ravenna, Italy; Koper, and Slovenia before disembarking the ship in Venice, Italy. We'll fly home from Venice. The rates for this segment of the cruise ranges from \$1,120 per person for an inside cabin to \$1,520 per person for a balcony cabin.

** Combined, these rates were less than the Alaskan cruise. **
